AND AROUND THE CLOCK.

Legend, myth, icon: the 911 has been the epitome of innovative design and engineering for 60 years. Created by the young Ferdinand Alexander Porsche, the successor to the 356 — initially christened the 901 — won the hearts of sports car fans from the very outset. Renamed as the now world-famous 911 in 1964, the icon has continued to illustrate what is still true today: that standing still is not an option for a sports car manufacturer. The progressive development and optimisation of all components for even better performance on the race track and everyday comfort has been part of the 911's recipe for success from the beginning. This is how new generations of the legendary Porsche have been created — from the G model to the 964 to the current 992.

These also include the 911 S/T 2.4., which was developed for racing using motorsport-proven lightweight components based on the 911 S and had the adrenalin of numerous Porsche enthusiasts pumping in 1970. Harking back to this legendary variant of the 911, there is now the new 911 S/T, rolled out for the 60th anniversary of the 911 and strictly limited to 1,963 coveted units. Along the same lines, Porsche Design presents the Chronograph 1 – 911 S/T, which incorporates the characteristic features of its motorised counterpart in numerous details, bringing them to your wrist. The handcrafted chronograph from the Porsche watch factory in Solothurn, Switzerland, is reserved exclusively for owners of the new 911 S/T.



TWO DESIGN ICONS.

INSEPARABLY UNITED.

'For me, it was about creating a watch to match the car.' Like the first 911, the iconic Chronograph 1 was designed by Prof. F.A. Porsche — and was the inspiration for this exclusive vehicle watch. The design principles have remained unchanged to this day to ensure optimum readability. The chronograph thus combines the best of both worlds. So it only makes sense that the lightweight construction concept of the Porsche 911 S/T has been transferred to the chronograph case, which is made of lightweight titanium. The high-quality details of the dial and the bezel ring in Black echo the display instruments of the 911 S/T.



The entire minute scale on the bezel ring recalls the heritage tachometer look — including the '60' highlighted in Red to mark the anniversary. All other numbers, the day and the date complete the look in Phosphorous Green.

The White stop-seconds hand matches the colour of the tachometer. Thanks to Super-Luminova® luminous material, the chronograph's minute and hour hands tell you the time even in the dark.

A printed gear shift pattern in Silver for the Chronograph 1 – 911 S/T and in Gold for the Chronograph 1 – 911 S/T Heritage underscores the close connection with the manually operated special model. The font of the letters H, M and S for hours, minutes and seconds is also derived directly from the gear shift pattern.

UNBELIEVABLY THRILLING – BOTH ON THE

RACE TRACK AND ON YOUR WRIST.

Even those who revel in the past need a watch that keeps time to the second in the present. Inside the titanium case, this task is performed by the Porsche Design flyback chronograph calibre WERK 01.240 with COSC certification — a distinction that is only awarded to extremely precise watches. One finely-tuned cog meshes with another, just like in the strictly limited model with manual 6-speed GT sports gearbox and high-revving naturally aspirated engine. Still, the highest demands are the ones we place on ourselves. This means that without exception, each and every chronograph is checked once again before delivery by our Swiss factory for compliance with the COSC precision values. Quality standards that are a matter of course for Porsche.



The flyback function enables starting, stopping and zeroing in one operation. Protected behind a clear, sevenfold, anti-reflective sapphire crystal window, the movement is driven by a rotor with the look of the magnesium wheel from a Porsche 911 S/T — optionally available in Brilliant Silver, Dark Silver (satin finish) or Black (satin finish). Ceramica (satin finish) and Brilliant Silver are the colours available for the Chronograph 1 — 911 S/T

Heritage. The focus of attention is the rotor cap with the S/T graphic print in Brilliant Silver for the Chronograph 1 – 911 S/T or with the historic Porsche crest for the Heritage version. To make it clear that it is your vehicle and your chronograph, you will find your limited edition number laserengraved on the back of the titanium case.
